2.50 Club Streets of Saigon Cabramatta NSW

WHEN: Friday 26 April

WHERE: Wynyard Station York Street entrance (Outside) 09.30am

TIME: We meet at 09.30 (9.30 am) sharp at the York Street entrance to Wynyard station just off the footpath. All travellers to make their own way to Wynyard by train, bus or ferry. Don't be late as we will not wait I! We will be catching the 9:44am train to Cabramatta from Platform 5 however check on the day that there has been no changes.

WHAT: You will need your OPAL CARD. As a group we will take the T2 line train direct from Wynyard to Cabramatta Station with travel time 1 hour, so come prepared. Cash/cards for your lunch. Sensible clothing and shoes for walking and weather.

THEN: We will walk to John Street and Cabramatta central (10 minutes) taking in the sights, sounds and smells of this unique corner of Vietnam in Sydney. The street stalls and fabric shops along with Asia grocery markets and so many restaurants preparing for lunch.
