April Guest Speaker

Gordon Ingate OAM - 'Super Aussie Sailor'

"SAILOR— 9 yo to 98 yo"

Over a yachting career spanning 82 years, Gordon has represented Australia in the Admiral's Cup and the Olympic Games, challenged for the America's Cup, won the prestigious 8-race Prince Philip Cup in Dragons (2008, 2015 and 2017) and was very close to winning the Sydney to Hobart Race with "Caprice of Huon" in 1972. At the age of 91 he won the Prince Philip Cup Dragon Class [skiff] Championship.

Arguably one of the best and oldest one-design yachtsmen in the world, 98-year-old Royal Sydney Yacht Squadron member Gordon Ingate is a truly remarkable helmsman. *In 2020*, Gordon received a Lifetime Achievement Award from Australian Sailing, the governing body for the sport of Sailing in Australia. He has also been rewarded with an OAM.
