Prof. Oates has a 50-year career in paediatrics and has long-standing clinical and research interests in child development, child behaviour and child abuse. He is internationally recognised, particularly with regard to his pioneering research in child protection and as a clinician, researcher, teacher and administrator.

He was Chairman, Division of Medicine, at the Royal Alexandra Hospital for Children at Camperdown and was CEO of the Children's Hospital at Westmead for 9 years.

Prof. Oates developed a passion for patient safety and from 2008 to 2018, he was a consultant for the NSW Clinical Excellence Commission (CEC). There, he developed a program for patient safety education for undergraduates to show how doctors can work more safely to reduce patient harm.

He lives in Mosman, has been married for 56 years, has 3 children and 9 grandchildren, and enjoys travelling, theatre, politics and kayaking amongst other things.

In 2020 he was made an Officer of the Order of Australia.
