Dear fellow members, partners and guests

Over the next six months our club will focus on a significant milestone in its history, the fortieth anniversary of its establishment in February 1980. Late in 1979, the Rotary Club of Neutral Bay determined it should sponsor and form a Probus Club in the area. A meeting to test interest was held at the

Cammeray Golf Club on Tuesday 12 February 1980. Rotarians and 10 Probians from other clubs attended to lend support.

A club was formed, the thirteenth in NSW and one of seventeen clubs celebrating forty years in 2020. Our inaugural President, **Don Mackie** chaired the first meeting attended by 28 members. Joining fee was one dollar, with an annual subscription of two dollars. In 1982 membership grew to forty one necessitating a move to the Anzac Memorial Club in Cammeray. It remained there till 2002 when it moved to its present venue, North Sydney Leagues Club. The club had been incorporated in 1987.

The format of club meetings changed little during the whole period apart from the introduction of '10 Minute Speaker' in 2003. I consider this segment, now called 'Personal Corner', as significant. It seems better to hear and share one's active story rather than hearing it in panegyric form as we are laid to rest. Over the coming months our Executive will focus on our history and how we can grow our great club.

PROMOTION: Hugh Seccombe and I will head this activity and welcome ideas and support.

MEMBERSHIP is in the hands of **Peter Turner** and **Stewart Horwood**. It is pleasing to report we have 118 financial members and three others to be inducted.

FEEDBACK was another important sub-committee. Ross Bruwel and Peter Davenport welcome your valuable feedback on Speakers, Outings and Meeting Format.

Each of the above sub committees will present an action plan at our next executive meeting. As a committee we are as animated as the Australian Cricket Team that broached Fortress Edgbaston. So fellow members here's to an ever better club where fun and friendship abound.
