Then, the following Monday, 14 Lost Soles Strollers, ably led by Stewart Horwood, participated in a very interesting guided walk through historic Balmain and even those who missed the ferry ('no names no pack drill'), demonstrated great initiative and eventually managed to locate us in Balmain.

Not to be outdone, the following day, perhaps fittingly just before Anzac Day, some 37 of us visited the Sydney Jewish Museum in Darlinghurst, outstandingly organised by Tony Michaels. Carolyn and I have visited a number of similar memorials and sites from the amazing Holocaust History Museum in Jerusalem, the heart wrenching camps at Auschwitz- Birkenau and Mauthausen and the Jewish Ghettoes in Prague and Warsaw and while the feelings of revulsion are always there, on this occasion they were reinforced by a lengthy address by a Holocaust survivor, 93 year old Egon Sonnenscheim. (Photo below). Egon and his family escaped during the war from the then Yugoslavia through Italy and eventually into Switzerland. Egon's presentation was an outstanding and emotional experience, which he still managed to lighten with some humorous memories.

Meanwhile, the more active have continued with Tennis, Golf, Lawn Bowls, Croquet, Cycling and Sailing, while others have enjoyed David's Movie Group. So, there's plenty to do and a very big thank you to the organisers of all of our activities. That said, our next major activity is the Hawkesbury River Postman Cruise, including morning tea and lunch, on Tuesday 16th May and encompassing a guided history of the early Hawkesbury years. This is one of the highlights on our calendar, enjoyed year after year by our members; so, why not join in.


Guided Tour of the Archibald, Wynne and Sulman Prizes Tuesday 27th June

May Speaker Dr Garry Lowder "A Journey through the Elements - Memoirs of a Fortunate Geologist"



Dr Garry Lowder's Presentation is an entertaining account of one man's journey through life as a geologist. Garry is a geologist who spent over 50 years in the Australian and international mining industries. As an exploration geologist, Garry worked in Australia, Indonesia and Papua New Guinea, playing key roles in the discovery of several mineral deposits. Later he held senior management positions with Australian mining companies and spent four years in government as Director General of Mineral Resources in NSW. In 1997 he founded Malachite Resources Ltd, a minerals exploration company, retiring as Managing Director in 2011. Garry will introduce his memoir (published by Connor Court Publishing in 2019) and also provide some insights into why understanding how our planet works is so important for our long-term survival.
